Respect for Self and Others

- I will be kind, courteous, and respectful to fellow campers, staff, and volunteers.
- I will use appropriate language at all times.
- I will keep my hands, feet, and objects to myself.

Respect for the Camp Environment

- I will take care of camp property, equipment, and supplies.
- I will clean up after myself and help keep shared spaces neat.
- I will report any damage or unsafe behavior to a counselor, supervisor, or director.

Electronics and Belongings

- I understand that I am responsible for any personal electronics I bring and understand that Martial Way Summer Camp or any of its staff are not responsible for the loss, damage, or theft of my electronics.
- I will not bring inappropriate or dangerous items to camp.
- I will be responsible for my personal belongings.

Behavior Expectations

- I will follow directions from all Martial Way staff.
- When off site, I will stay with my group unless otherwise instructed.
- I will participate fully and try my best in all activities.

Unacceptable Behaviors (May Lead to Disciplinary Action or Dismissal)

- Bullying, teasing, cursing, or threatening others.
- Physical aggression or violence.
- Repeated refusal to follow camp rules or staff instructions.
- Possession of weapons, drugs, or other prohibited items.
